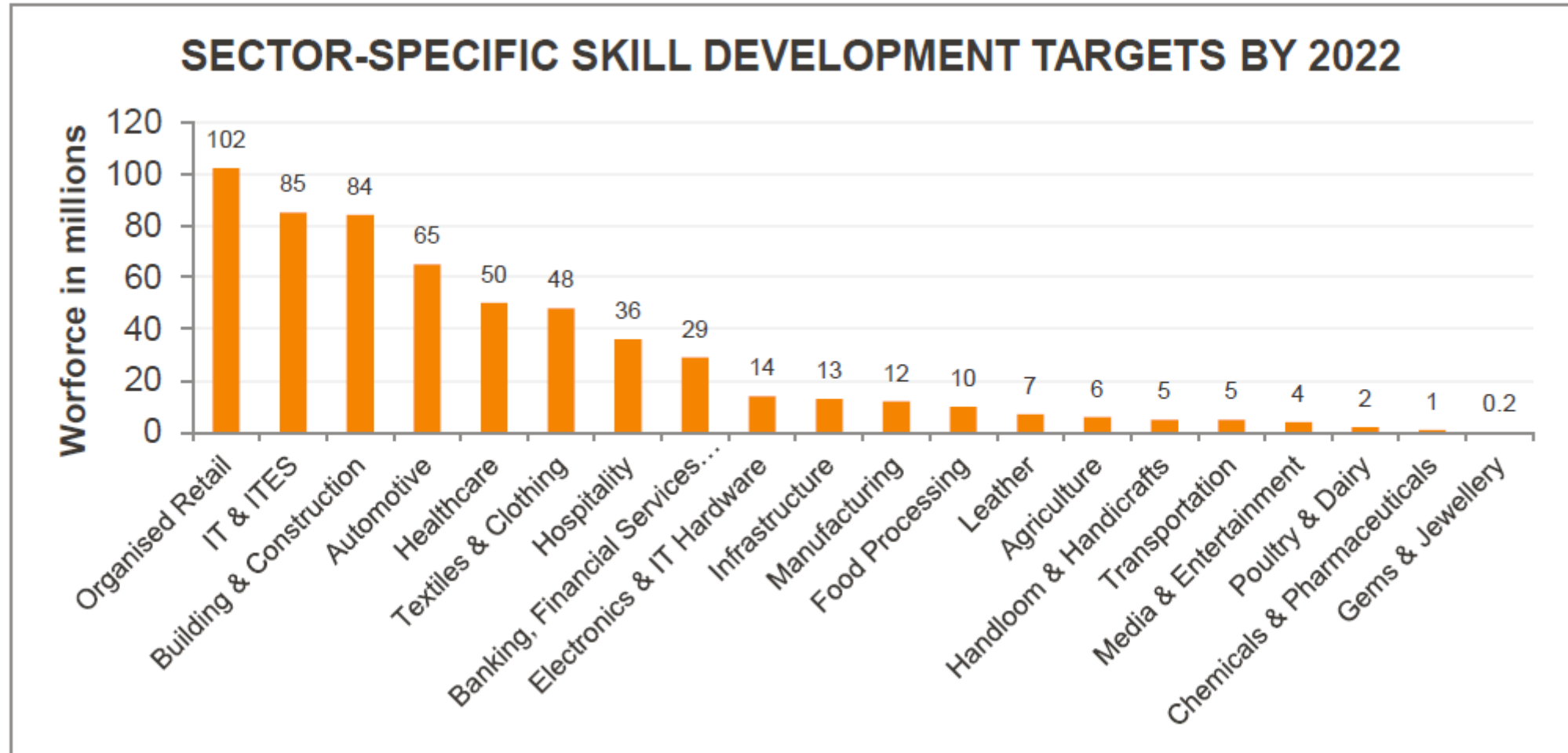

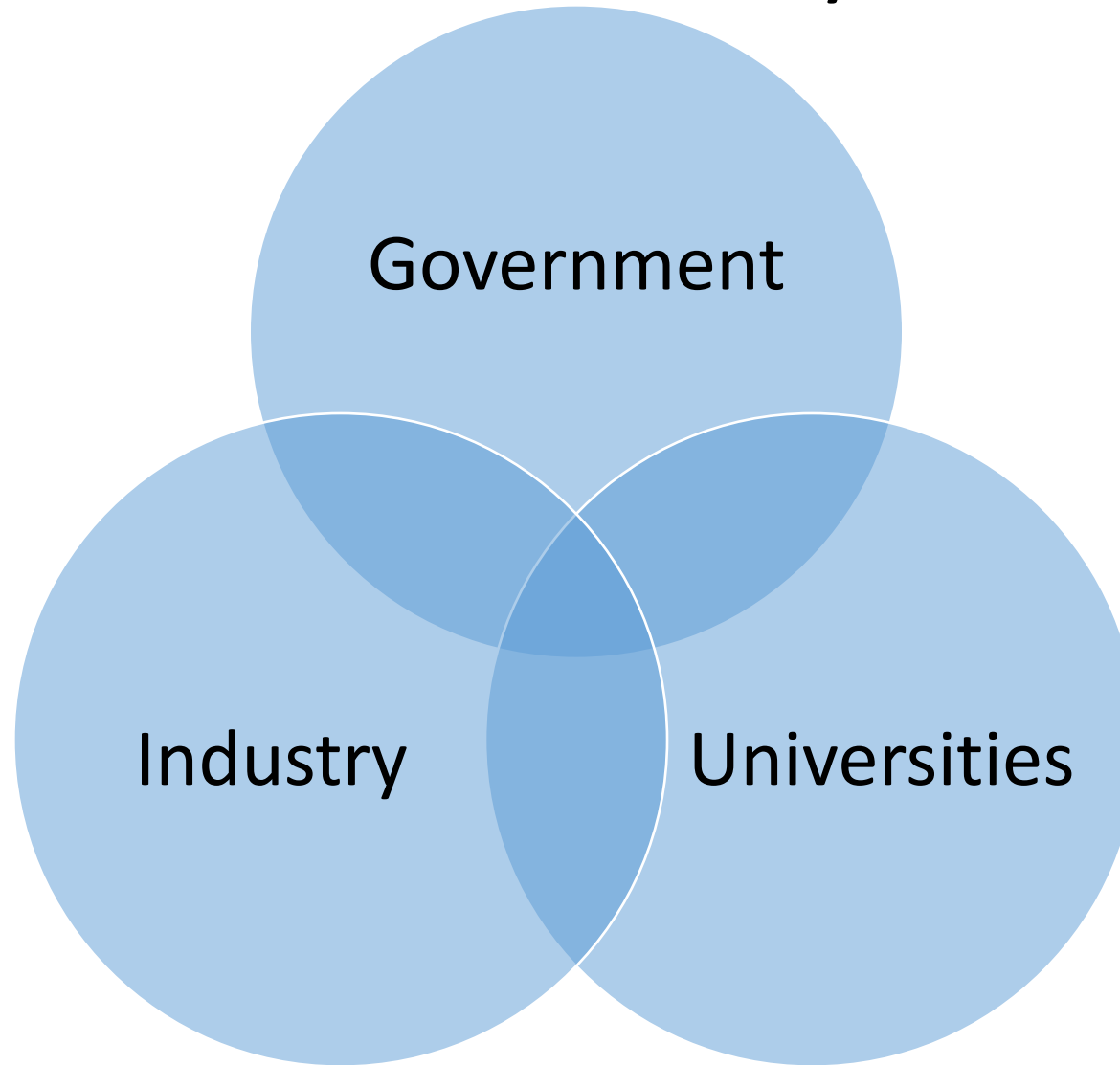

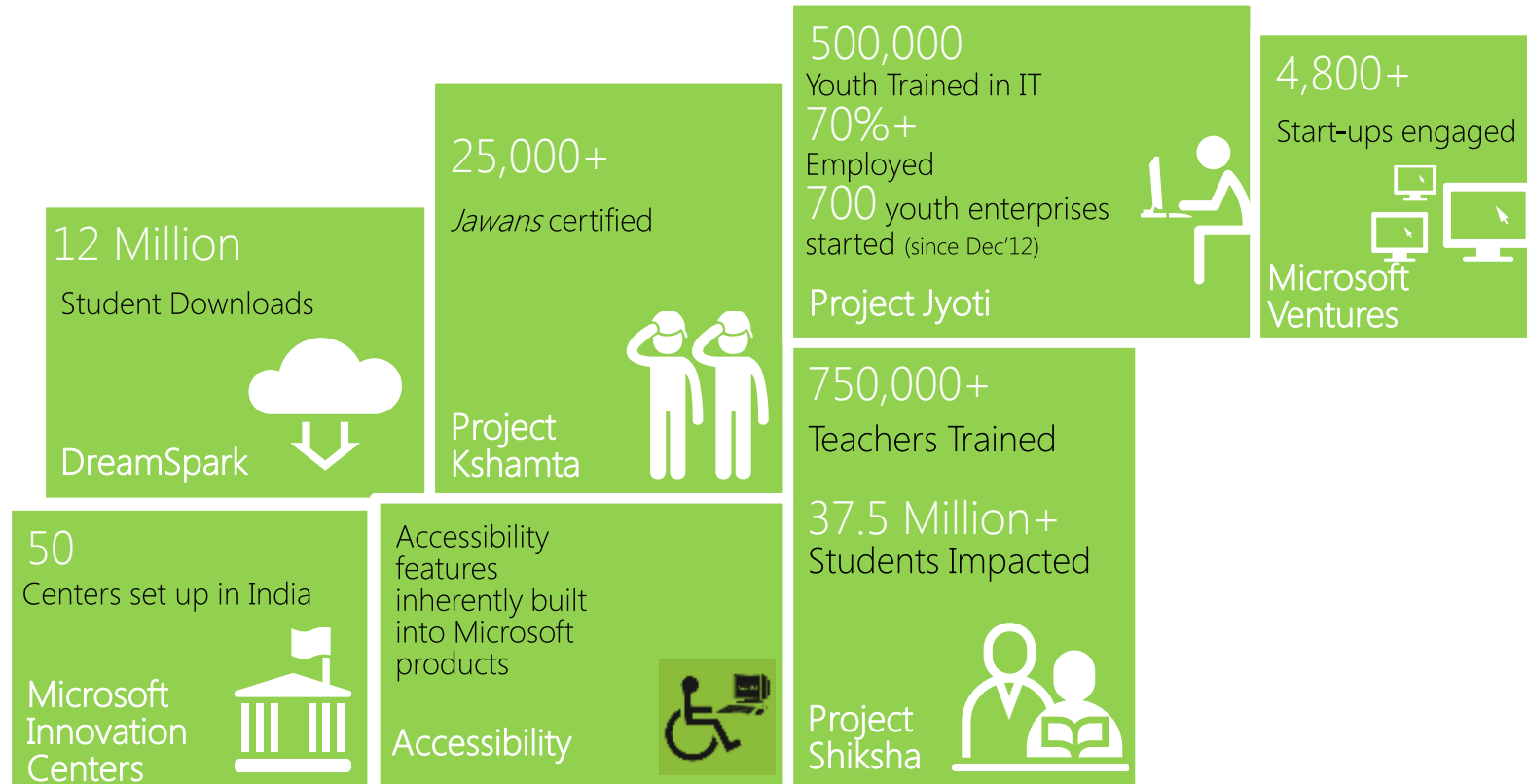
Industry's Role and Contribution to Employability
